IRWA Course 218 - Electrical Transmission Acquisition: This two-day course is designed to create awareness of the process involved in the acquisition of real estate with electrical utilities on projects.

IRWA Course 203 - Alternative Dispute Resolution: This two-day course provides right of way professionals alternative methods to resolve negotiation disputes.

Aug 8-9th

IRWA Course 215 - Right of Way Acquisition for Pipeline Projects: This two-day course is designed to create awareness of the process involved in the acquisition of real estate for pipeline projects.

IRWA Course 600 - Environmental Awareness: This course is an overview of various environmental issues and mitigation measures used to decrease impact upon the environment, including an introduction to the National Environmental Policy Act and other important legislation.
